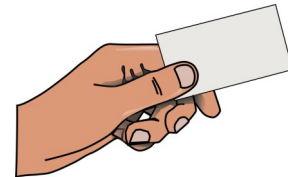

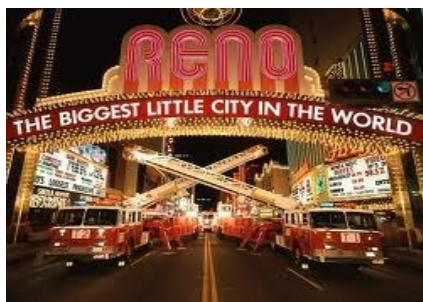

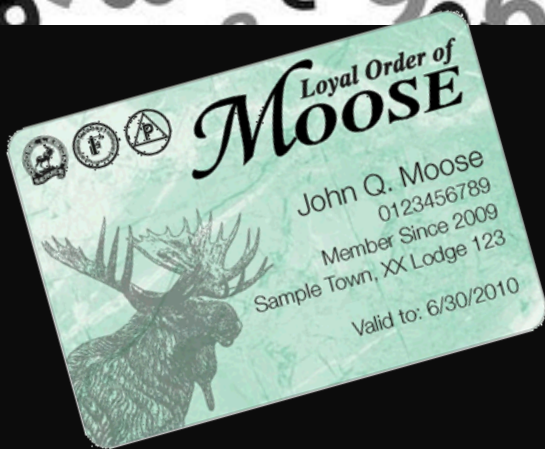

Your Membership in your Lodge, and the activities you participate in, are part of those privileges and should not be abused.

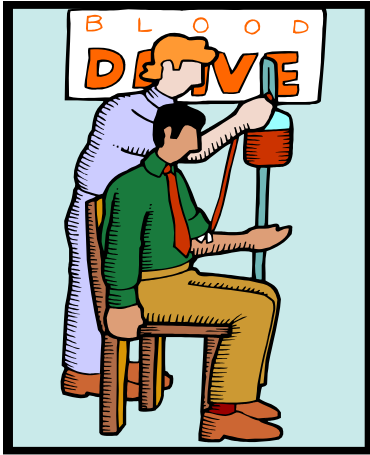
